Door Entry & Recess




Student Agenda Book

Technology

- Students are assigned a Chromebook to use for the year
- Gr 5,6,7 students carry Chromebook from class to class, encouraged to purchase soft carrying case
- Students will use the same Gmail account from the Sherbrooke location, new students will be assigned a Gmail account.
 Students are not to share passwords with others, to ensure security of account.
- Combination of paper and digital homework in classrooms
- Do not rely on Google Classroom as an agenda. Not all handouts or assignments are posted on Google Classroom.
- Students are expected to use their school Gmail accounts responsibly both during and outside of school hours.
